Foster homes for orphans

BENEFIT: There are over 600 children under care of the Society and fully accommodated in foster homes. They are being provided with a good home and a lot of tender loving care. All these children were originally saved from the streets and are being given education, health care and a unique opportunity to develop themselves.

Vocational training for young people and adults



One of the most important projects in Sudan this initiative provides an opportunity for young people and adults to develop skills which will eventually lead to a job or self-employment.

Medical programmes

PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE FOR 50 TREATMENTS £100

35,000 treatments are provided by 2 mobile and 8 permanent clinics every year. Many treatments are for potentially fatal diseases such as Malaria.
