**Baby Feeding Programme**



..... "the one day which would change the rest of my life was in 1998 when I first visited a baby feeding centre run by the SVP in Sudan. The sight of these starving children always moves the most hardened and experienced care worker to tears"..... instead of saying we're keeping babies alive we should be saying we're stopping babies from dying. Somehow that brings home the life or death situation with which we are dealing. Words seem so inadequate.....

In 1998 the SVP opened one feeding Centre which fed 230 babies every other day; since then the programme has peaked at an astounding 10,000 babies a day for 5 days a week. Recently, because of shortage of funds, a number of Centres had to be closed and as a result 3,000 babies could not be fed; they had to rely on what could be found through the local population of displaced people.

The good news is that **all of the baby-feeding centres have now been reopened thanks** to the generosity of people in England & Wales **supported in the short term by the SVP in Australia**. The feeding centres which are based near the camps for displaced people not far from Khartoum are again providing nourishing food for babies 3 times a week. Vast numbers of the population have been displaced as a result of years of civil unrest in southern Sudan and more recently in Darfur.

The SVP established this program after learning that, in the poorest areas of the suburban shanty towns, several hundred children under the age of five were suffering from malnutrition so serious as to cause irreversible brain damage.

When you visit a baby feeding centre today the babies appear to be well nourished and well looked after. This dramatic change has been brought about, and can only be maintained with the continued generosity of the people here - **WE REALLY ARE KEEPING BABIES ALIVE! – and giving them hope for the future.**

It costs £40 a year to provide nourishing food which will give a child a better future, nothing really is it?

## Vocational training for young people and adults



One of the most important projects in Sudan this initiative provides an opportunity for young people and adults to develop skills which will eventually lead to a job or self-employment.

**BENEFIT:** Those supported **become self-sufficient and not reliant on charitable support. This also gives them DIGNITY** This programme helps not just this generation but generations to come.

It costs **£100 to train 2 adults.**

## Medical Programme

35,000 treatments are provided by 2 mobile and 8 permanent clinics every year. Many treatments are for potentially fatal diseases such as Malaria. **The medical staff give their time voluntarily.**

**BENEFITS:** Countless lives have been saved by this programme and many disabilities have been prevented.

It costs **£60 to treat 20 patients**
